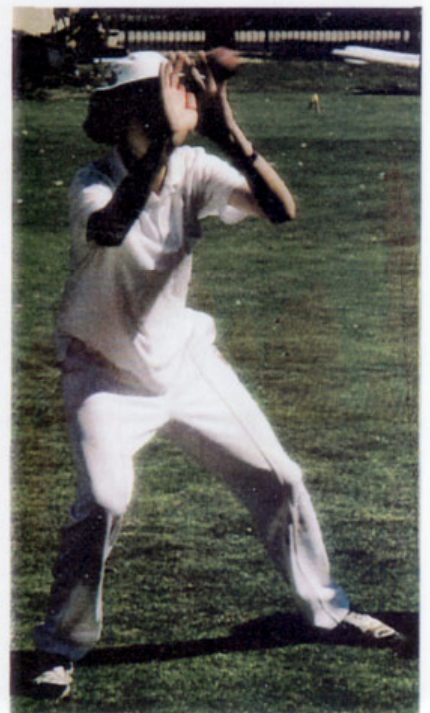

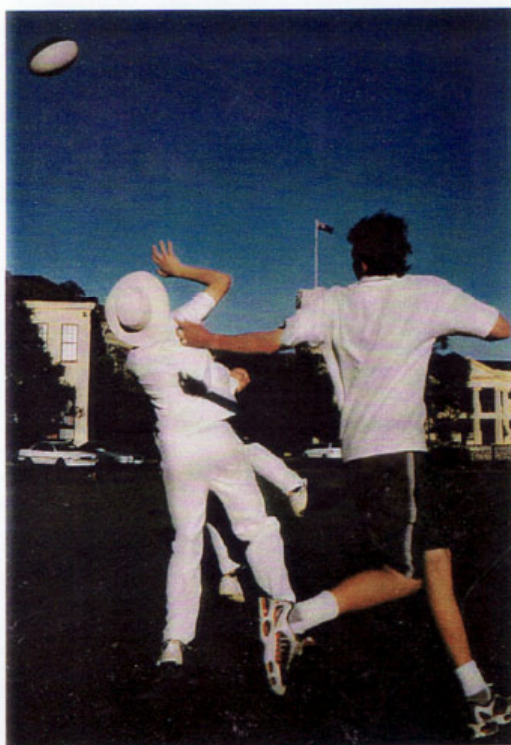

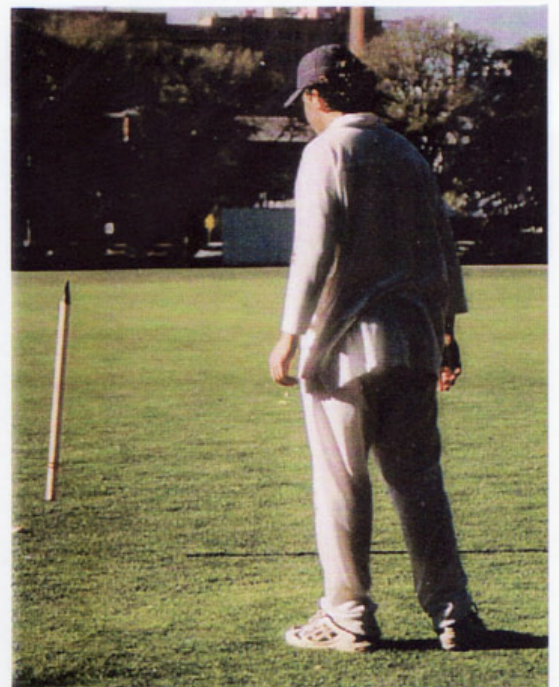

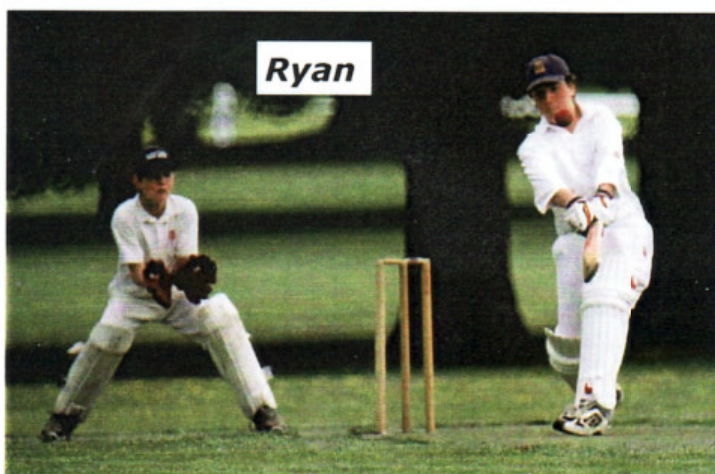

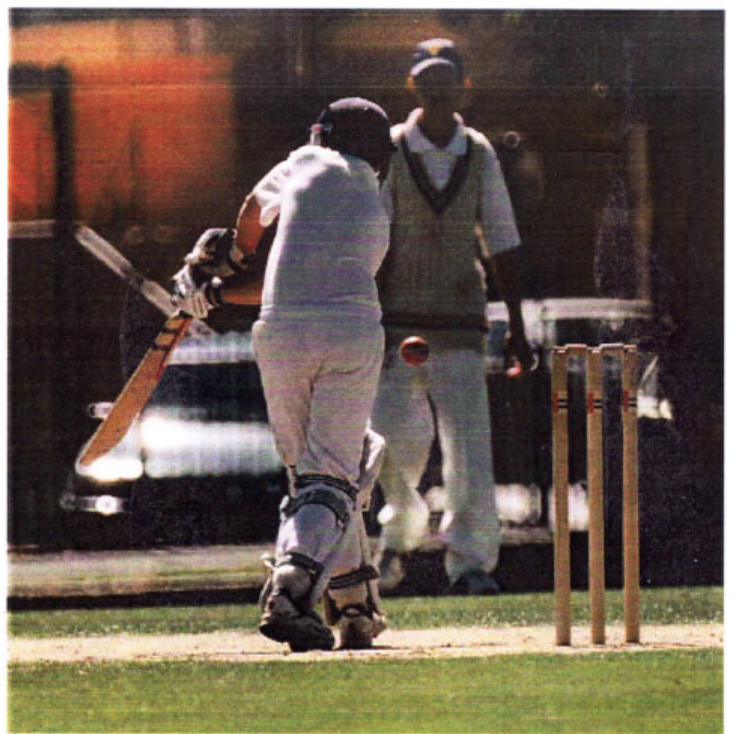

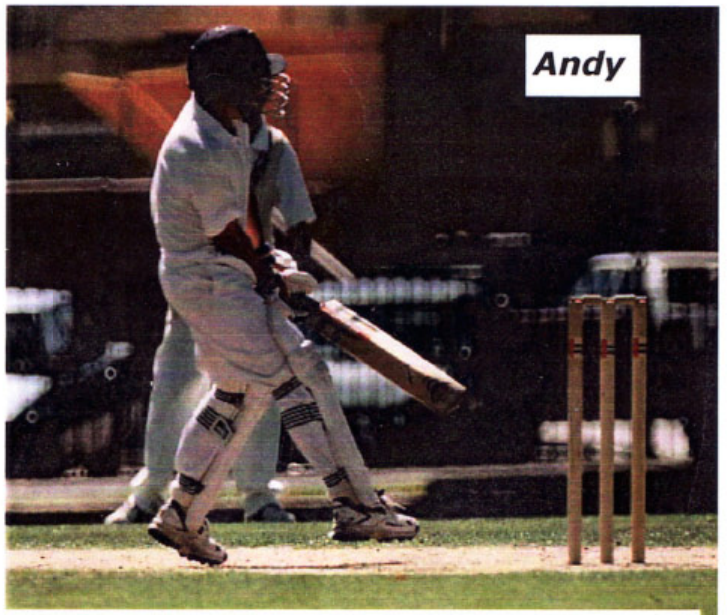

Everybody takes us keepers for granted, but where would you be without us? Have you any idea how much stress and strain our bodies have to take? Have you seen Ian Healey's hands? My knees are pretty bad and my groin has been a real problem lately. That's why we like fieldsmen to keep the ball up! But don't let me put you off kids! It's worth all the effort when you snap up a one hander down the leg side or whip the bails off when a gun batsman is beaten by the spin!



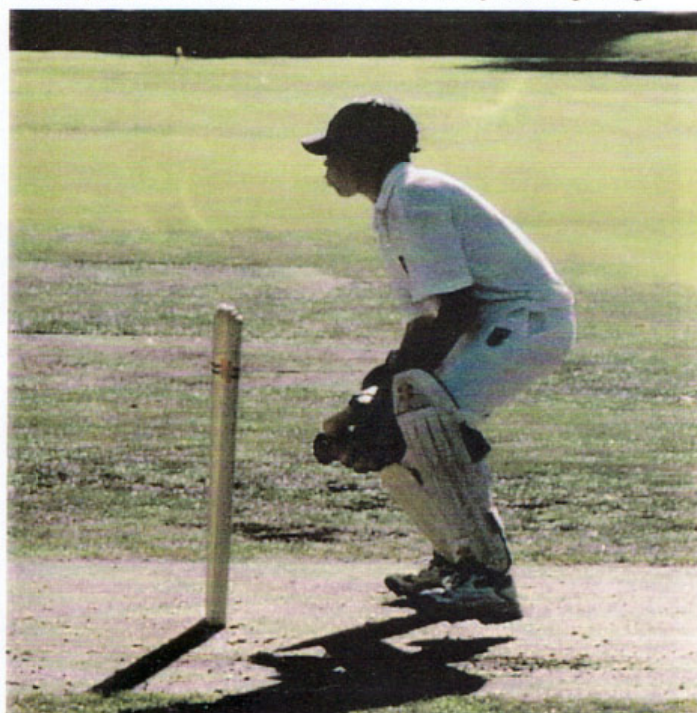
Some days it can be lonely being a keeper... but not here. That's some cordon!



This must have been pretty close to a stumping! Reflexes like greased lightning.



The trick is to watch the ball and the batsman's feet simultaneously
