In a memorable year for Wesley football, enjoyment, satisfaction and scoreboard success were features shared by the SKR Fourth XVIII.

A key group of 2009 veterans stepped up to provide leadership and became the nucleus of a strong, well balanced combination. Consistent hard work and tireless running by Lee Kosky, Seb Lindner and Jack O'Donnell kept the engine humming, whilst Will Cook, Sam Pinto and Mike Kus added spark in the midfield and around the goals. Sam's lazy eight goals at Haileybury was a highlight. Tom Baker again took control of the ruckwork but this season he received valuable support from the Crash'n'Bash expert, James Kus, as well as from Henry Howson and Dan Warwick when they were temporarily relieved of defensive duties.
