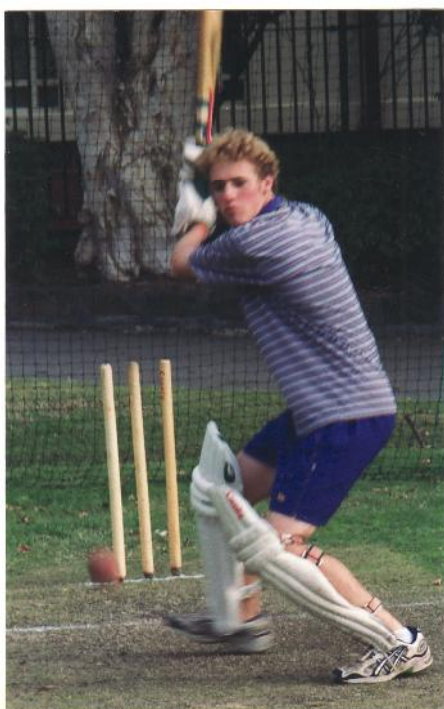
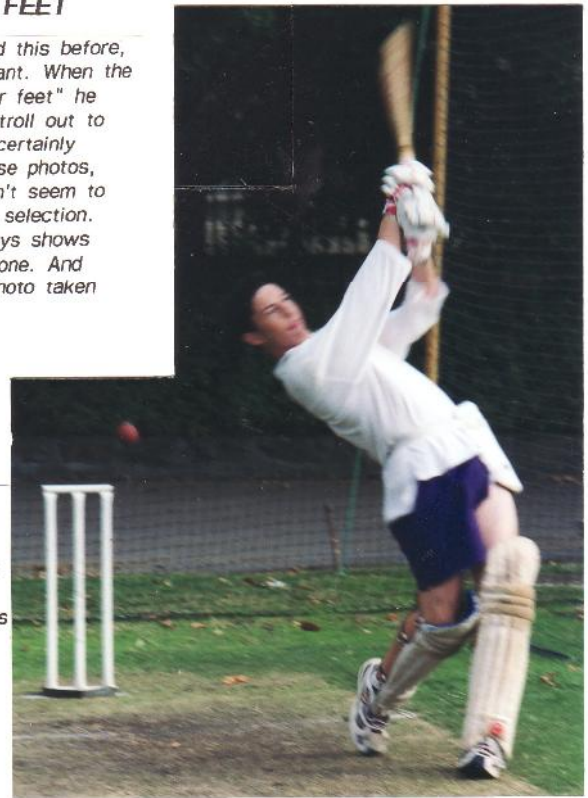
MOVING YOUR FEET
