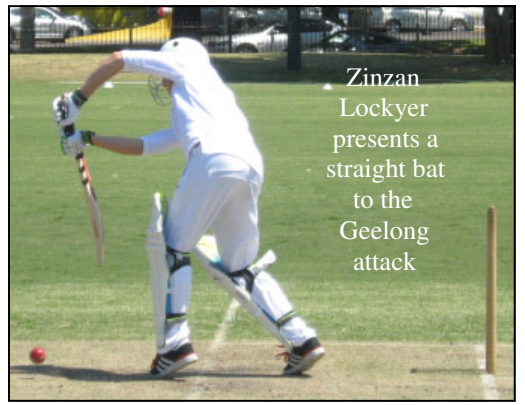
Another hot and sunny afternoon in beautiful downtown Prahran

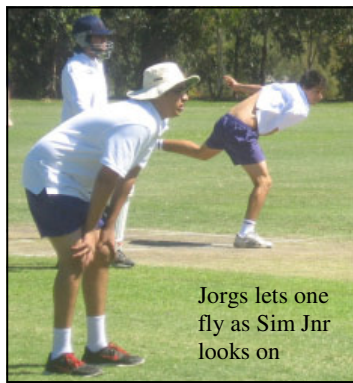
The long trek to the edge of the civilised world
